## Digging Deeper – April 26, 2026 – Revelation Recap, Pt. 2 – Living Faithfully

### For the Follower of Jesus, A Key Theme in Revelation is Be an Overcomer

The book of Revelation was written to encourage believers facing pressure, temptation, suffering, and spiritual warfare. Jesus calls His people to **overcome**.

“To the one who overcomes...” (This promise appears repeatedly in Revelation 2–3.)

Overcoming is not about being stronger than everyone else—it is about remaining faithful to Jesus.

### What have we learned from Revelation about what an overcomer looks like?

1. **Overcomers Hold Fast to Christ –2:10, 3:11** Victory belongs to those who do not quit.
2. **Overcomers Resist Compromise – 2:14-15, 3:15-16**, An overcomer chooses holiness over convenience.
3. **Overcomers Trust the Blood of the Lamb – 12:11**, We overcome by what Christ has done, not by our own strength.
4. **Overcomers Receive Eternal Reward – 2:7, 2:11, 3:5, 3:21, 21:7**, Jesus promises great blessings to those who endure. Temporary battles lead to eternal reward.

**\*\*\*\*Our Greatest Enemy: Ourselves – Pride, Unbelief, Fear, Laziness, Bitterness, Lust, Self-Centeredness, Stubbornness. – See James 1:14, Romans 7:24-25**

**Truth:** The hardest person to deal with is the one we see when we look in the mirror. **This week talk to the person you see when you look in the mirror, ask that person some questions.**

1. Where am I being called to overcome right now?
2. Am I battling external enemies while ignoring internal ones?
3. What promise of Jesus gives me strength today?
4. What would change if I truly believed victory is already mine in Christ?

Because Jesus overcame, His people can overcome. – Rev.5:1-14, 3:21
