Then after I jumped awhile, I started telling every day -

It seems far fetched, but it's a true story. One presumed to be dead was really alive, and oh, the joy that mom felt when she heard the voice of her son again.

Jesus presumed dead, is alive! The one who was dead, lives, and offers us hope, not only for this life but eternity!
