Job, Isaiah 55:8-9, Habakkuk 1:5
- 2) Discipleship is not an INTELLECTUAL PURSUIT.
1 Corinthians 1:20-31, 8:1, Matthew 23:13-40, Micah 6:8. Revelation 2:1-7
- 3) God's PLAN is always clear in the Rearview Mirror.
Don't expect to have it figured out AHEAD OF TIME.
John 20:9, 1 Peter 1:10-12
- 4) God's FAITHFULNESS is not dependent upon our confidence and understanding.
John 20:1-2, 11-14, 2 Corinthians 1:20, Proverbs 21:30, 19:21, 16:4, Philippians 1:6, Luke 17:3-6

GREAT NEWS FOR THE WORLD WITHOUT CHRIST

“But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.” John 20:31 (KJV)

John begins his account of Jesus by stating who Jesus is – John 1:1-5

Jesus tells us who he is – John 6:35, 8:12, 10:9, 10:11-14, 11:25, 14:6, 15:1-5

Will you accept Jesus today? Believe what the Bible tells us about Him, Who He is, what He did and trust Him today to forgive your sins and to save you. Make your faith (belief) in Jesus public by baptism.
